


2017 GREGOR SHIRAZ

HOBBS OF BAROSSA, BAROSSA VALLEY, AUSTRALIA



THE WINE:

100% Shiraz from the Hobbs Estate vineyard with vines planted in 1988. The fruit is hand picked before being placed on racks and semi dried in the style of the famous Amarone wines of Italy. The grapes lose much of their water through evaporation which concentrates the flavors and natural richness of the fruit. The grapes are then naturally fermented in open vats, resulting in a wine that is powerful and potent reaching over sixteen degrees of alcohol. The wine is aged in new French Oak barrels for a period of 24 months. Bottled unfiltered. This 2017 vintage yielded just over 700 cases. 95 points Robert Parker.

THE ESTATE:

Greg and Alison Hobbs purchased the property in 1995 after years of living in the big cities of Australia. Greg was a former police officer and member of the elite SWAT team in Sydney. The Hobbs Vineyard sits atop the lofty peaks of the Barossa Range above Flaxman's Valley. The original vineyard was planted in 1905. With a deep respect for nature and for the traditions of the region, the vineyard is grown using sustainable agricultural practices without irrigation. Hobbs winery produces a range of wines with the emphasis being on the mighty Shiraz grape. Production is extremely limited with an annual case production of only 1,800 cases per year.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: dense purple with maroon hues

Aromas: black plums, ripe blackberries, vanilla and warm spice

Flavor & Texture: round, velvety and full bodied the flavors of black fruits and vanilla linger on the palate while the tannins are big and bold yet seem soft and plush

Food Pairing: coffee rubbed pork shoulder slow cooked and served with an apple, jicama slaw
