

2012 FLORIANNA ZINFANDEL

FREDIANI VINEYARD



THE WINE:

80% Zinfandel from 80 year old vines, 10% Petite Sirah, 3% Cabernet Sauvignon, 3% Cabernet Franc – from Frediani Vineyard. 4% Coombsville Tannat.

Barrel fermented and aged for 24 months in French oak.

THE ESTATE:

The Frediani Vineyard was planted in 1900 by the grandfather of its current owner Jim Frediani. Located at the Northern end of Napa Valley on Pickett road in Calistoga this property has earned the reputation as one of Napa Valley's prized vineyards. Sitting at the base of Mt. St. Helena the soil is of a volcanic origin with a rocky, golden alluvial soil. The non-irrigated vines are exceptionally low-yielding and hand-cared for by the Frediani family.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Deep ruby-garnet.

Aromas: Brambly blackberry and ripe raspberry with juicy dark plums. Hints of white pepper and vanilla.

Flavors: Mouth pleasing and round with fruit forward berry and plum. Subtle spice.
