THE WINE:

77% Zinfandel from 106 year old vines, 12% Syrah, 10% Petite Sirah from Luvisi Vineyard. 1% Tannat from Coombsville.

Barrel fermented and aged for 24 months in French oak.

THE ESTATE:

The Luvisi Vineyard was planted in 1908 by the grandfather of its current owner Clarence Luvisi. Located at the Northern end of Napa Valley in Calistoga this property has earned the reputation as one of Napa Valley's prized vineyards. Sitting at the base of Mt. St. Helena the soil is of a volcanic origin with a rocky, golden alluvial soil. The non-irrigated vines are exceptionally low-yielding and hand-cared for by the Luvisi family.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Dark ruby-garnet.

Aromas: Deep, complex black raspberry, dusty cocoa and incense-laced dark cherry with hints of sandalwood.

Flavors: Soft and plush on your palate, wonderfully drinkable with cassis, dark chocolate, and hints of white pepper.
