

2017 FOGGY CANYON GRENACHE

RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY, SONOMA, CALIFORNIA



THE WINE:

100% Grenache from a single vineyard. The Campbell-Mckinney Vineyard planted along the Russian River. The Vineyard was planted about 25 years ago primarily with Syrah, Grenache and Viognier and is grown organically. This cool climate site allows the Grenache grapes to ripen slowly and without the jammy and overripe qualities that can sometimes plague Grenache wines here in California. Winemaker Brian Kobler, of Kobler Family Vineyard, made only 70 cases of this special bottling in 2017.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: light garnet red

Aromas: crushed blue and red berry fruit with subtle hints of spices and mineral

Flavor & Texture: bright and juicy with red fruits and wet stones; whispers of fresh tea and tart cherry on the finish with a silky, yet surprisingly round mouthfeel

Food Pairing: a classic paella made with fresh shellfish and Spanish sausage served with crunchy bread
