

2018 FOGGY CANYON PINOT NOIR

RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY, SONOMA, CALIFORNIA



THE WINE:

100% Pinot Noir made by winemaker Brian Kobler, of Kobler Family Vineyard. The fruit was sourced from three small vineyard sites along the Russian River with most of the fruit coming from the Moore Vineyard and the Anderson Ross Vineyard. After hand picking of the fruit and careful sorting the grapes were gently pressed with partial whole cluster fermentation. The wine was then aged in 25% new French oak for 16 months prior to being bottled in late February 2020.

THE ESTATE:

The Foggy Canyon wines are produced by the partnership of winemaker Brian Kobler and Quigley Fine Wines with assistance from consulting winemaker Jim Olsen. The fruit is typically sourced from sustainable vineyards from Sonoma's Russian River Valley, AVA and produced in small batches of less than 150 cases.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: bright ruby

Aromas: ripe raspberry, fresh picked wildflowers, potpourri, and hints of exotic tea leaves

Flavor & Texture: sweet red and blue fruits with subtle notes of loamy earth and vanilla bean; the texture is silky and seamless

Food Pairing: grilled salmon in a raspberry - chipotle glaze
