THE WINE:

100% Viognier from the Fair Play Farms Vineyard of El Dorado County, CA. The Fair Play AVA is California's highest average elevation; this vineyard sits at 2,400 feet above sea level. Aged in French oak (10% new/90% neutral) for 6 months with stirring of the lees every 2 - 3 days. Winemaker Scott Johnson made only 125 cases of this wine.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: platinum gold

Aromas: tropical fruit, honeysuckle flowers and fresh peach

Flavor & Texture: crisp peach and honey with bright, vibrant acidity. Round and creamy on the palate.

Food Pairing: grilled mahi-mahi with a Jamaican jerk seasoning served with a rum-banana sauce.
