

2019 GOLD MINER TEROLDEGO

THE WINE:

A single vineyard micro-production (70 cases made) wine made by Jim Olsen and Brian Kobler born from grapes grown in Lodi, CA. The Teroldego varietal is native to the Trentino - Alto Adige region of Northeast Italy, an area known for its crisp, mineral driven whites and cool climate reds. The grape has been grown in this area for centuries and has become known as the region's best red varietal. Several plantings of this grape are found in Lodi and the Sierra Foothills AVA. Cool soaking, gentle pressing of the fruit followed by ageing in French oak for 12 months.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Dark shade of violet

Aromas: Black fruits, bitter dark chocolate, perfumed spice, and hints of anise

Flavor & Texture: Blackberries, dried herbs and white pepper flavors are supported by supple and mild tannins with juicy, bright acids

Food Pairing: Wine braised chicken thighs with wild mushroom, onions, fresh herbs and bacon
