

2014 LARKSONG GRENACHE SYRAH BLEND

CENTRAL COAST, CALIFORNIA



THE WINE:

A blend of 69% Grenache and 31% Syrah from a selection of small vineyard sites in California's central coast AVA. This wine was made by Russel From from Herman Story wines in partnership with Absentee Wines, a small, boutique winery that was started by Russel and a few winegrower friends. Aged in American and French oak barrels for 24 months prior to being bottled in November 2016. Only 72 cases were produced.

THE ESTATE:

Larksong Wines represent the collaboration between Quigley Fine Wines and winemakers Vailia Esh, of Desparada Wines and Russel From of Herman Story Wines. Sourcing grapes from sustainably grown vineyards in the Central Coast region of California and focusing on small production, terroir driven wines these passion project wines are available only through Quigley Fine Wines.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: maroon/garnet

Aromas: red berries, rose petals and exotic far eastern spices

Flavor & Texture: ripe red berries and vanilla with soft, velvet tannins that have evolved and integrated beautifully after 4 years in the bottle

Food Pairing: bbq chicken thighs with a honey, hickory bbq sauce
