

# 2014 PINOLI COLE PINOT NOIR BLANC



## **THE WINE:**

100% Pinot Noir from the Angel Camp vineyard in Mendocino's Anderson Valley. The Pinot Noir grape can yield white wine when the juice is gently extracted and no skin contact is allowed. The grapes were whole-cluster pressed and the resulting juice was fermented in stainless steel tanks at cold temperatures to retain the freshness and acidity.

Winemaker Alex Crangle made only 65 cases of this wine.

## **TASTING NOTES:**

**Color:** Straw-gold.

**Aromas:** Citrus blossom, white peach, chamomile oil.

**Flavors & Texture:** Flavors of baked apple, white cranberry and wet stone with hints of white pepper and mineral.

**Food Pairing:** White pizza with ricotta, crème fraîche and fresh sage.
