

2019 PIPEVINE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

NAPA VALLEY, CALIFORNIA



THE WINE:

94% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Merlot and 2% Cabernet Franc from three small vineyards in the Napa Valley. Most of the fruit comes from Mt Veeder, approximately 60%, with 20% from Oakville and 20% from Rutherford. Aged for 18 months in 33% new French oak. Winemakers Sal Galvan and Jim Olsen made only five barrels of this vintage (just over 100 cases). By combining the structure and elegance provided by the Mt. Veeder fruit with the power and ripeness provided by the Oakville and Rutherford fruit we were able to create an approachable, yet age-worthy wine that embodies the classic Napa Valley Cabernet style.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: dense shade of ruby

Aromas: wild red and black berries along with red currants, hints of herbal notes and dried violets

Flavor & Texture: ripe red berries, baked cherries, warm spices and supple, elegant tannins

Food Pairing: flame grilled filet mignon with a wild mushroom and red wine reduction
