

2013 WILD ROVER PINOT NOIR

SANTA CRUZ MOUNTAINS
CALIFORNIA



THE WINE:

100% Pinot Noir from the Tindall Mountain Vineyard in the Santa Cruz Mountains AVA. This relatively small AVA – only 1,500 acres under vine – produces high quality and sought after wines. Predominantly planted to Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, and Cabernet, the cool maritime-influenced climate here and elevations between 800 – 3,000 feet allow for slow maturation of Pinot Noir fruit resulting in wines with complex aromas and excellent structure.

Total of 135 cases produced by winemakers Jim Olsen and Sal Galvan.

Barrel aged for 12 months in 75% new/25% 1 year old French oak.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: True ruby-garnet.

Aromas: Bing cherry, red raspberry and graham cracker crust. Hints of fresh tea and subtle notes of caramel-vanilla.

Flavors: Red berry fruit and tart cherry yielding to exotic spices and silky, soft tannins.

Food Pairing: Grilled salmon with a honey-Dijon mustard sauce served over fresh watercress.
