

# 2017 PROJECT M ACCLARA ROSE

## WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OREGON



### THE WINE:

A unique blend of approximately 60% Pinot Noir and 40% mixed white varietals all from the Willamette Valley, Oregon. The Pinot Noir vineyards were selected by Jerry Murray, winemaker at Project M, because of their tendency to produce fruit with low tannins, high acids and pronounced flavors at low sugar levels. The grapes were whole cluster pressed and then fermented in stainless steel. Less than 200 cases were made in this vintage.

### THE ESTATE:

Project M is the vision of Meg and Jerry Murray. With over 30 years of collective wine industry experience, our methods and principles have been tested and refined, our vision focused and our judgments sharpened. We use this experience to craft precise and elegant Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Rosé and Riesling from distinctive sites in the Willamette Valley. Project M isn't the place we have arrived at; it is a new chapter on a long journey.

**Color:** light salmon pink

**Aromas:** bright cherry and cranberry with subtle earth and herbal spice

**Flavor & Texture:** lifted red cherry and hints of watermelon with tart mouthwatering acids

**Food Pairing:** cold shellfish platters with fresh lemon
