THE WINE:

This limited production white blend consists of 32% Pinot Noir, 32% Pinot Gris, 32% Pinot Blanc (barrel fermented), 3% Chardonnay and 1% Riesling. By combining all three of the Pinot family varietals winemaker Jerry Murray was able to create a wine with great complexity that showcases the varietals for which the Willamette Valley is famous.

Color: Sunrise hued gold.

Aromas: Citrus and pear along with hints of mineral.

Food Pairing: Slow roasted Turkey along with the classic Thanksgiving fare.
