A single vineyard, 100% Pinot Noir from the rugged and cool climate of the Oregon Coast Range. This sub region of the Willamette Valley AVA is known to produce wines of depth, complexity and aromatic intensity. Aged for 12 months in 20% new French oak prior to bottling.
