THE WINE:

A 100% Pinot Noir sourced from two small, sustainably grown vineyards in the Willamette Valley. Hand harvesting, careful selection and gentle pressing to ensure that only perfectly ripened fruit made it into the final blend. Winemaker Jerry Murray created 7 barrels of this wine. Aged in French oak for 10 months prior to bottling.

Cases made - 170

Jerry Murray's winemaking resume includes Patton Valley Vineyards, Van Duzer Vineyards and his most recent position of winemaker at Domaine Anderson. His passion for the Pinot Noir varietal along with his overall winemaking philosophy make him a perfect partner for creating limited volume, sustainably produced wines in this very special region.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Cranberry with ruby highlights.

Aromas: Red cherries, black tea along with subtle lavender notes.

Flavor & Texture: Fresh red berries and pomegranate lead to a silky, soft texture with elegant and fine tannins.

Food Pairing: grilled Chinook salmon with a raspberry and honey glaze.
