THE WINE:

100% Pinot Noir from a single vineyard in the Eola-Amity Hills AVA of the Willamette Valley, OR. The vineyard was planted in 1977 to a single Pommard Clone and is grown without pesticides with the fruit being hand picked and sorted. Aged for 12 months in a combination of 30% new French oak and 70% 1 and 2 year old barrels.

Winemaker Jerry Murray made 77 cases of this reserve.
