THE WINE:

100% Pinot Noir from three of the Willamette Valley's most prominent sub-AVAs; Dundee Hills, Yamhill-Carlton and Chehalem Mountain. By blending these three vineyard sites into one bottle Jerry Murray was able to bring out the best attributes of each area. Aged for 12 months in 20% new French oak. Cases made 150.

THE ESTATE:

Bellflower Wines represent the collaboration between winemaker Jerry Murray and Quigley Fine Wines to produce world class wines in Oregon's Willamette Valley. Jerry Murray's winemaking resume includes Patton Valley Vineyards, Van Duzer Vineyards and his most recent position of winemaker at Domaine Anderson. His passion for the Pinot Noir varietal along with his overall winemaking philosophy make him a perfect partner for creating limited volume, sustainably produced wines in this very special region.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: deep ruby red

Aromas: wild berries and cherry mingle with exotic spice and purple flowers

Flavor & Texture: rich red fruits lead to baking spices and whispers of vanilla; soft and plush on the palate

Food Pairing: grilled cedar plank Chinook salmon with dill, Dijon mustard and wild herbs
