THE WINE:

Made from 100% Pinot Noir grapes from two, small vineyards in the Van Dozer Corridor sub-region of the Willamette Valley. This cool climate area is perfect for sourcing Pinot Noir grapes intended for Rosé wines. Minimal skin contact and fermentation in stainless steel ensures freshness and acidity. Winemaker Jerry Murray only made 53 cases of this wine in 2017.

THE ESTATE:

Bluebell Wines represent the collaboration between winemaker Jerry Murray and Quigley Fine Wines to produce world-class wines in Oregon's Willamette Valley. Jerry Murray's winemaking resume includes Patton Valley Vineyards, Van Duzer Vineyards, and his most recent position, winemaker at Domaine Anderson. His passion for the Pinot Noir varietal along with his overall winemaking philosophy make him a perfect partner for creating limited volume, sustainably produced wines in this very special region.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: light, pale pink with a rose hue

Aromas: fresh picked berries, wild flowers and hints of watermelon rind

Flavor & Texture: white berry and Meyer lemon flavors and supported by crisp acids in a lively and vibrant mouthfeel, a truly elegant and refreshing style of Rose

Food Pairing: extremely versatile; anything from grilled salmon with a raspberry, honey, and balsamic glaze to fresh salads and seafood cocktails
