THE WINE:

100% Gewurztraminer from the famous Zotzenberg Grand Cru property. This 90 acre Grand Cru is split between many producers and yields some of the most prized fruit in all of Alsace. Considered one of the two great varietals of Alsace (the other being Riesling), this wine is one of the greatest expressions of Gewurztraminer in the world.

THE ESTATE:

Winemaker Daniel Haegi began making wine in 1985 and is the 3rd generation Haegi to make wines on this tiny farm in Mittelbergheim, Alsace. Organically grown grapes with a great respect to native and traditional methods. Riesling, Gewurztraminer, Sylvaner, Pinot Blanc and Pinot Gris are the main grapes grown here.

~Tasting Notes~

Color: Deep platinum/light gold.

Aromas: Tropical lychee and green melon with classic rose petals and honeysuckle notes.

Flavors & Texture: Ripe and complex with juicy honey-dipped fruit. Whispers of honey and round, soft acidity.

Food Pairing: Grilled mahi-mahi with a pineapple soy honey glaze.
