THE WINE:

100% single vine Pinot Blanc from 35 year old vines. Hand harvested, double sorted. 500 cases produced. No pesticides used and biodynamic methods during growing season.

THE ESTATE:

Winemaker Daniel Haegi began making wine in 1985 and is the 3rd generation Haegi to make wines on this tiny farm in Mittelbergheim, Alsace. Organically grown grapes with a great respect to native and traditional methods. Riesling, Gewurztraminer, Sylvaner, Pinot Blanc and Pinot Gris are the main grapes grown here.

Color: Platinum-straw.

Aromas: Tropical guava and star fruit with traces of jicama and clean mineral.

Flavors & Texture: Citrus fruit with subtle tropical notes, crisp acidity and refreshing flavor.

Food Pairing: Fresh cracked crab with drawn butter.
