THE WINE:

100% single vine Pinot Gris from 35 year old vines. Hand harvested, double sorted. 500 cases produced. No pesticides used and biodynamic methods during growing season.

THE ESTATE:

Winemaker Daniel Haegi began making wine in 1985 and is the 3rd generation Haegi to make wines on this tiny farm in Mittelbergheim, Alsace. Organically grown grapes with a great respect to native and traditional methods. Riesling, Gewurztraminer, Sylvaner, Pinot Blanc and Pinot Gris are the main grapes grown here.

~Tasting Notes~

Color: Platinum-straw.

Aromas: Bosc pear, Meyer lemon, and mineral.

Flavors & Texture: Crisp and refreshing with vibrant acidity. Flavors of lemon and green apple laced with minerals and notes of tropical fruit.

Food Pairing: Fresh grilled fish or lemon pepper shrimp.
