

2013 DOMAINE HAEGI RIESLING ZOTZENBERG GRAND CRU DOMAINE HAEGI, ALSACE, FRANCE



THE WINE:

This 100% Riesling comes from the world famous Grand Cru Zotzenberg property located in Mittelbergheim, Alsace, France. The 32 acre property is home to some of the worlds best Riesling grapes. The 32 acres is divided amongst over 20 wineries, with Domaine Haegi owning just over one acre of vines here. Winemaker Daniel Haegi is able to produce just under 200 cases of a spectacular Riesling from the precious vines. Organically grown and made this wine is capable of ageing up to 30 years!

THE ESTATE:

Winemaker Daniel Haegi began making wine in 1985 and is the 3rd generation Haegi to make wines on this tiny farm in Mittelbergheim, Alsace. Organically grown grapes with a great respect to native and traditional methods. Riesling, Gewurztraminer, Sylvaner, Pinot Blanc and Pinot Gris are the main grapes grown here. The winery produced less than 6000 cases per year in total.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: silver-platinum

Aromas: classic green apple and citrus are met with minerals and oil-like shale

Flavor & Texture: highly concentrated with lemon oil and apple leading to a long, complex finish with hints of stone fruit and pineapple rind

Food Pairing: Dover sole done in a citrus butter sauce
