

2014 DOMAINE HAEGI PINOT BLANC

DOMAINE HAEGI, ALSACE, FRANCE



THE WINE:

100% single vineyard Pinot Blanc from 35-year-old vines. Hand harvested, double sorted. 300 cases produced. No pesticides used and biodynamic methods during growing season. Certified as organic wine – “Vin Biologique” – by the European Union in 2013.

THE ESTATE:

Winemaker Daniel Haegi began making wine in 1985 and is the 3rd generation Haegi to make wines on this tiny farm in Mittelbergheim, Alsace. Organically grown grapes with a great respect to native and traditional methods. Riesling, Gewurztraminer, Sylvaner, Pinot Blanc and Pinot Gris are the main grapes grown here. The winery produced less than 6000 cases per year in total.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: platinum gold

Aromas: tropical fruit and citrus mingle with jasmine floral notes

Flavor & Texture: bright and juicy mandarin and lemon with honey kissed pears; fresh, clean acids on the vibrant finish

Food Pairing: fresh cracked crab with drawn butter
