

2018 DOMAINE HAEGI PINOT BLANC

DOMAINE HAEGI, ALSACE, FRANCE



THE WINE:

100% single vineyard Pinot Blanc from 35-year-old vines. Hand harvested, double sorted. The juice was fermented and aged in stainless steel. 300 cases produced. Biodynamic methods used during the growing season and no pesticides. Certified as organic wine, Vin Biologique, by the European Union in 2013.

THE ESTATE:

Winemaker Daniel Haegi began making wine in 1985 and is the 3rd generation Haegi to make wines on this tiny, organic farm in Mittelbergheim, Alsace. Organically grown grapes with a great respect to native and traditional methods. Riesling, Gewurztraminer, Sylvaner, Pinot Blanc and Pinot Gris are the main grapes grown here. The winery produces less than 6,000 cases per year in total.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: straw-gold

Aromas: apple, pear and citrus fruit with floral nuances

Flavor & Texture: yellow peach, red apple and with whispers of minerals; crisp on the finish yet with a medium body; clean, elegant and precise

Food Pairing: risotto with spring vegetables, fresh herbs and grated Parmesan cheese
