

2010 COTES DE BERGERAC

CHATEAU LA ROBERTIE



THE WINE:

40% Merlot, 40% Cabernet Franc, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon. Aged 14 months in New French oak. Age of vines – 20–30 years.

THE ESTATE:

Chateau La Robertie is owned and operated by Brigitte and Jean Philippe Soulier. They purchased the 17th century estate and vineyards in 1999. Planted with 7 acres of red grape and 7 acres of white, they produce wines with a deep connection to the land. Practicing organic viticulture since 2008 they were certified as “A.B.” (Agriculture Biologique) in 2011.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Deep garnet with good color density.

Aromas. Concentrated black plums and currants with toasted vanilla oak and lilac flowers.

Flavors & Texture. Round, soft and medium bodied with ripe chewy fruit reminiscent of black currant and cassis.

Food Pairing. Grilled chicken breast with a fig and balsamic glaze.
