

2011 “LA ROBERTIE HAUTE”

CHATEAU LA ROBERTIE



THE WINE:

50% Merlot, 25% Cabernet Franc, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon. Aged 16 months in New French oak. Age of vines – 30 years.

THE ESTATE:

Chateau La Robertie is owned and operated by Brigitte and Jean Philippe Soulier. They purchased the 17th century estate and vineyards in 1999. Planted with 7 acres of red grape and 7 acres of white, they produce wines with a deep connection to the land. Practicing organic viticulture since 2008 they were certified as “A.B.” (Agriculture Biologique) in 2011.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Deep ruby with purple/blue highlights.

Aromas: Concentrated blueberry, toasted vanilla oak, meaty spices.

Flavors & Texture: Round, voluptuous and full bodied with ripe chewy fruit reminiscent of black currant and cassis.

Food Pairing: Filet mignon with a rich balsamic/red wine glaze.
