CHATEAU LA ROBERTIE, FRANCE



THE WINE:

45% Cabernet Franc/28% Cabernet Sauvignon/27% Merlot.
Aged for 16 months in new French oak. Average age of vines
30-40 years old. Total production of under 400 cases.

THE ESTATE:

Chateau La Robertie is owned and operated by Brigitte and
Jean Philippe Soulier. They purchased the 17th century estate
and vineyards in 1999. Planted with 7 acres of red grape and
7 acres of white, they produce wines with a deep connection
to the land. Practicing organic viticulture since 2008, they were
certified as A.B. , Agriculture Biologique, in 2011.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: glowing violet with deep ruby

Aromas: wild blueberry, black currants and dried flowers

Flavor & Texture: black cherry with cassis and toasted oak;
the seamless and almost creamy mouthfeel coat the palate on
the long, complex finish

Food Pairing: filet mignon with a rich balsamic/red wine
glaze
