CHATEAU LA ROBERTIE, BERGERAC, FRANCE



THE WINE:

48% Cabernet Sauvignon / 33% Merlot / 19% Cabernet Franc. Aged for 16 months in new French oak. Average age of vines 30-40 years old. This wine is only produced on years where the quality of the fruit allows it, with a selection of grapes from the Estate's older vines. Total production of under 400 cases.

THE ESTATE:

Chateau La Robertie is owned and operated by Brigitte and Jean Philippe Soulier. They purchased the 17th century estate and vineyards in 1999. Planted with 7 acres of red grape and 7 acres of white, they produce wines with a deep connection to the land. Practicing organic viticulture since 2008, they were certified as A.B., Agriculture Biologique, in 2011.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: glowing purple violet

Aromas: black currant, smoked earth, with herbaceous notes

Flavor & Texture: black fruits and cigar box lead into a rich texture with dry tannins and hints of French oak

Food Pairing: beef bourguignon with wild mushrooms and wide ribbon egg noodles
