

2017 RULLY 1ER CRU LES CLOUX WHITE BURGUNDY

DOMAINE DES CHAUCHOUX, RULLY, BURGUNDY, FRANCE



THE WINE:

100% Chardonnay from the Premier Cru Vineyard of Les Cloux on the eastern slopes of the famous limestone ridge called La Montagne de la Folie. This ridgeline separates Rully from its more famous neighbor Chassagne Montrachet. The wine was fermented and then aged in 30% new french oak for 11 months. The 2017 vintage for this region was brilliant with generous fruit and ideal balance between acids and sugars. Domaine des Chauchoux produced around 1,200 cases of this wine in 2017.

THE ESTATE:

Domaine des Chauchoux is the new Domaine owned by Christian Belleville, former owner of Chateau Saint Michel. His family vineyards and winemaking traditions go back four generations in Rully with the same vineyards and lands being passed on down through the generations. The winery produces about 10,000 cases per year, split equally between red and white wines. The soils here in Rully are based with clay and limestone with the Pinot Noir plots being grown on clay based soils while the Chardonnay is grown on the limestone rich soils. Christian Belleville and his children Jean Michel and Amelie do much of the winemaking and vineyard maintenance where they practice sustainable agriculture and ancient Burgundian winemaking techniques.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: light gold with green reflections

Aromas: honeysuckle flowers, lemon and peach with flinty mineral and hints of creamy oak

Flavor & Texture: ripe citrus fruit and quince mingle with honey and minerals; round and rich in the mouth with a seam of acidity to keep the wine lifted and bright

Food Pairing: dover sole with a lemon and butter sauce
