COLLIOURE - BANYULS, LANGUEDOC FRANCE



THE WINE:

90% Grenache Gris / 10% Grenache Blanc. Entirely estate grown fruit from a vineyard set on a cliff above the Mediterranean Sea. Hand-picked and gently sorted. Wine is fermented in oak casks and part of the juice is matured for 6 months in 2 year old barriques.

THE ESTATE:

Domaine St. Sebastien draws from its 14 acres of A.O.C. property in the acclaimed "Collioure" district. This area is regarded as the best red wine producing region in the Languedoc. All of the vines sit on steeply terraced slopes which cannot be harvested by mechanical means. They are grown without pesticides. This low-yielding philosophy results in wines of great quality and clear expression of the terroir in which they are grown.

TASTING NOTES:

COLOR: Platinum-silver.

AROMAS: Fresh and clean with notes of green melon, citrus and traces of shale and mineral.

FLAVORS AND TEXTURE: Vibrant and clean with hints of tropical fruit, apple, jasmine and hints of jicama.

FOOD PAIRING: Serve with a classic country French salad of shrimp and avocado over butter lettuce with a lemon vinaigrette dressing.
