

2015 DOMAINE VINCENT MOREAU RASTEAU

COTES DU RHONE VILLAGES, SOUTHERN RHONE VALLEY, FRANCE



THE WINE:

70% Grenache, 15% Mourvedre, 15% Carignan. The grapes are fermented under cool temperatures for between 20-25 days. The wine is then aged in small barriques for 12–15 months. The 2015 vintage is one of the top 3 vintages of the last 25 years for this region.

THE ESTATE:

Domaines Vincent Moreau was established in 2002 when Vincent Moreau, a former geologist and wine lover, traded in his teaching job to become a vintner. His vineyards are in the famous communes of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Rasteau, and Cairanne. The soils are varied from clay, limestone, and gravel, each with a distinctive imprint on the wines. Grown without heavy intervention he prefers to let nature decide each vintage. The wines that carry his name Domaines Vincent Moreau are his smallest bottlings and showcase the unique terroir of the Southern Rhone.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: dark garnet red

Aromas: ripe berry fruit mingles with wild herbs and spice; hints of wet stones

Flavor & Texture: juicy, fresh blackberry and strawberry with whispers of mineral and earthy spice

Food Pairing: slow coked country French stew with chicken, carrots, mushrooms and potatoes in a red wine, garlic and wild herb sauce
