

# **2011 CHARLES TYRAND “SIGNATURE” C.D.R.**

**VIGNOBLES CHARLES TYRAND  
COTES DU RHONE, FRANCE**



## **THE WINE:**

80% Grenache Noir from 100 year old vines near the village of Rochegude. 20% Syrah from 60 year old vines near the Tyrand estate. 12 months in New French oak barriques. Total production 275 cases.

## **THE ESTATE:**

Charles Tyrand is a tiny producer with vineyards in the Cotes du Rhone and Cotes du Rhone Villages appellations. Located near the town of Seguret, they grow classic Southern Rhone red varietals of Syrah, Grenache, Mourvedre, Cinsault and Carignan. The vines are grown without the use of pesticides and range in age from 10 to 80 years old. Total production is below 3,000 cases each year.

## **TASTING NOTES:**

**Color:** Dark maroon-ruby.

**Aromas:** Ripe berries, garrigue (herbs of Provence) and toasted oak.

**Flavors:** Sweet blue and red berries with hints of vanilla spice. Round, voluptuous texture.

**Food Pairing:** Provençal beef stew with fingerling potatoes, carrots, onion and wild mushrooms.
