THE WINE:

60% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 20% Cinsault. All fermentation and aging is without an oak influence at all. Total production is 300 cases.

THE ESTATE:

Charles Tyrand is a tiny producer with vineyards in the Cotes du Rhone and Cotes du Rhone Villages appellations. Located near the town of Seguret, they grow classic Southern Rhone red varietals of Syrah, Grenache, Mouvedre, Cinsault and Carignan. The vines are grown without the use of pesticides and range in age from 10 to 80 years old. Total production is below 3,000 cases each year.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Ruby-garnet hue.

Aromas: Bright red berries and potpourri spices with hints of crushed slate.

Flavors & Texture: Juicy, ripe raspberry and cherry skins. Fresh, light, clean with “lip-smacking” acidity.

Food Pairing: Roasted chicken and grilled vegetables.
