

# 2012 CHARLES TYRAND “SECRET DES ROCHES” C.D.R.

## **THE WINE:**

80% Grenache, 20% Syrah from the village of Rochegeude. Vines average 50 years old. Aged 12-15 months in French oak.

## **THE ESTATE:**

Charles Tyrand is a tiny producer with vineyards in the Cotes du Rhone and Cotes du Rhone Villages appellations. Located near the town of Seguret, they grow classic Southern Rhone red varietals of Syrah, Grenache, Mourvedre, Cinsault and Carignan. The vines are grown without the use of pesticides and range in age from 10 to 80 years old. Total production is below 3,000 cases each year.

## **TASTING NOTES:**

**Color:** Deep garnet with brick red hue.

**Aromas:** Dark red berries and hints of garrigue spice.

**Flavors:** Ripe strawberry and raspberry with subtle spices and traces of vanilla oak.

**Food Pairing:** Slow cooked chicken with herbs d'Provence.
