VIGNOBLES CHARLES TYRAND COTES DU RHONE, FRANCE



THE WINE:

100% Syrah from 60 year old vines near the Puymeras area. Aged in New French Oak for 12 months. Total cases made; 250.

THE ESTATE:

Charles Tyrand is a tiny producer with vineyards in the Cotes du Rhone and Cotes du Rhone Villages appellations. Located near the town of Seguret, they grow classic Southern Rhone red varietals of Syrah, Grenache, Mourvedre, Cinsault and Carignan. The vines are grown without the use of pesticides and range in age from 10 to 80 years old. Total production is below 3,000 cases each year.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Maroon-ruby.

Aromas: Ripe berries, garrigue (herbs of Provence) , toasted oak, and white pepper spice.

Flavor & Texture: Sweet blueberries and herbal nuances with hints of vanilla spice. Round, voluptuous texture.

Food Pairing: Provencal beef stew with fingerling potatoes, carrots, onion and wild mushrooms.
