

2016 DELORENZI ROSSO DELL'ARCON

FRIULI, ITALY



THE WINE:

This 60% Cabernet Sauvignon and 40% Cabernet Franc is the red wine passion project of winemaker Carlo DeLorenzi. With only 8 barrels (200 cases) made each vintage and sourced from his oldest vines on his estate this is his best red wine each year. Careful vineyard selection and pruning results in low yields and insures only the best bunches are selected for this wine. Aged for 15 months in 50% new French oak.

THE ESTATE:

The De Lorenzi family have been producing wines in Friuli since 1973. They have vineyards in two D.O.C.s, Friuli Grave and Friuli Lison. The winery uses both modern technology and old world traditional methods. Winemaker Carlo De Lorenzi crafts small quantities of beautiful wines with a deep respect for the environment. The family practices sustainable agriculture with mechanical weeding instead of chemical, no pesticides, and maintaining low yield per acre.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: deep ruby - garnet

Aromas: ripe red currant and berries lead into pipe tobacco and cedar spices

Flavor & Texture: rich and wide on the mouth the flavors are ripe and intense with currants and cherry; the tannins are softened by French oak and the finish is long and complex

Food Pairing: a meat ragu served over fresh pasta, shaved pecorino
