## THE WINE:

100% Barbera

Single vineyard and estate grown. Entirely hand-picked fruit with a total production of just 600 cases. Aged in 100% new French Oak barrels for 24 months before bottling.

## The Estate:

Agricola Bertolino is located in the rolling Langhe hills near the town of Asti. This small, family-run farm produces under 4000 cases of wine annually. The grapes are grown pesticide-free using traditional “old-world” winemaking methods.

## ~Tasting Notes~

**Color:** Dark ruby with purple flashes.

**Aromas:** Ripe black berry and violet floral notes. Toasted vanilla oak with whispers of spice.

**Flavors and Texture:** Round and plump mouthfeel with forward sweet cherry and raspberry fruit. Vanilla oak and spice complement the ripe fruit with a rich chewy texture.

**Food Pairing:** Will pair perfectly with a grilled New York Strip in a mushroom-brandy cream sauce.
