THE WINE:

100% Nebbiolo from a single vineyard called Castelletto in Roero. The wine was barrel fermented and aged for 24-36 months in French oak. The Donna Costanza selection from the Castelletto Vineyard was a single barrel (25 case) selection of our favorite lots from the 2011 vintage.

THE ESTATE:

The property has been owned since the 15th century by the Canale family and has been producing wine since 1362. Located a few miles north of the town of Alba, the vineyards cover just over 20 acres and are all hand harvested using sustainable growing practices.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: bright ruby red with hints of an orange halo

Aromas: deep red fruits and baking spices with dried rose petals and hints of tobacco

Flavor & Texture: spiced red berry and dried floral flavors lead to a silky palate with bold acids and tannins

Food Pairing: fresh ribbon pasta with truffle oil, wild mush-rooms and sliced filet mignon
