
2011 ROERO ARNEIS "DONNA COSTANZA"

100% Arneis from all estate grown fruit. The Roero district is a D.O.C.G. for the Arneis grape and is known for producing the world's best examples of this rare Piedmont white.

THE ESTATE:

The property has been owned since the 15th century by the Canale family and has been producing wine since 1362. Located a few miles north of the town of Alba, the vineyards cover just over 20 acres and are all hand harvested using sustainable growing practices.

~Tasting Notes~

Color: Light sunshine gold with great clarity.

Aromas: Fruit and floral notes, with white flowers, melon and citrus.

Flavors: Juicy fruit with a crisp, dry finish. Hints of grapefruit, passion fruit and sliced almonds.

Food Pairing: Scallops, lobster or any shellfish. The classic pairing is fresh shucked oysters with a citrus vinaigrette.
