

2016 DONNA COSTANZA PRADVAJ ARNEIS

MALABAILA DI CANALE, PIEDMONT, ITALY



THE WINE:

100% Arneis from a single vineyard called Pradvaj in the Roero district of Piedmont. This area is a DOCG region for the Arneis grape and widely considered Piedmont's best white wine. The Pradvaj vineyard has a sandy, mineral rich soil that imparts great complexity and structure in the wine. Fermented and aged in stainless steel to preserve the freshness and vibrancy of the fruit this wine is capable of ageing up to 7 years from the vintage date.

THE ESTATE:

The property has been owned since the 15th century by the Canale family and has been producing wine since 1362. Located a few miles north of the town of Alba, the vineyards cover just over 20 acres and are all hand harvested using sustainable growing practices.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: platinum with hints of straw

Aromas: fresh peach and tropical fruits with almond notes

Flavor & Texture: peach mingles with citrus fruit along with hints of mineral; vibrant, crisp and clean

Food Pairing: pan seared scallops with a citrus beurre blanc sauce
