

2017 ROERO ARNEIS DONNA COSTANZA MALABAILA DI CANALE, PIEDMONT, ITALY



THE WINE:

100% Arneis from all estate grown fruit the wine is fermented and aged in glass-lined stainless steel to preserve freshness and acidity. The Roero district is a D.O.C.G. for the Arneis grape and is known for producing the world's best examples of this rare Piedmont white. This comes from a single vineyard planted exclusively to Arneis.

THE ESTATE:

The property has been owned since the 15th century by the Canale family and has been producing wine since 1362. Located a few miles north of the town of Alba, the vineyards cover just over 20 acres and are all hand harvested using sustainable growing practices.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: lighter shade of gold with great clarity

Aromas: citrus, minerals and honeysuckle flowers

Flavor & Texture: lemon, green melon and chalky-mineral with crisp acids and a refreshing finish

Food Pairing: scallops, lobster or any shellfish; the classic pairing is fresh shucked oysters with a citrus vinaigrette
