

MALABAILA DI CANALE DONNA COSTANZA “CARDUNAJ”

PIEDMONT, ITALY



THE WINE:

100% Brachetto grape from a small 2-acre vineyard near the estate in Roero, Piedmont. Only 250 cases made each year. Hand-picked, hand sorted, fermented without any oak. Brachetto is native to Piedmont and was believed to have aphrodisiac qualities going back 2000 years!

THE ESTATE:

The property has been owned since the 15th century by the Canale family and has been producing wine since 1362. Located a few miles north of the town of Alba, the vineyards cover just over 20 acres and are all hand harvested using sustainable growing practices.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Light garnet-cranberry red.

Aromas: Strawberry, cherry blossom and vine ripened raspberries.

Flavors & Texture: Ripe red berries and hints of medicinal herbs. The nose is sweeter than the palate where the fruit is ripe “up front” but gives way to a dry, elegant finish.

Food Pairings: Risotto with shrimp, asparagus and cherry tomatoes.
