

DONNA COSTANZA BIRBET NV

MALABAILA DI CANALE, PIEDMONT, ITALY



THE WINE:

This very playful and unusual wine is made from 100% brachetto grapes from a single vineyard planted 25 years ago. The wine goes through a partial fermentation which is stopped when the juice reaches 5-6 % alcohol, thus preserving the natural fruit sugars. The wine is lightly carbonated to create tiny, light effervescence. Less than 300 cases made.

THE ESTATE:

The property has been owned since the 15th century by the Canale family and has been producing wine since 1362. Located a few miles north of the town of Alba, the vineyards cover just over 20 acres and are all hand harvested using sustainable growing practices.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: fuchsia pink

Aromas: fresh picked raspberries and strawberries and hints of bing cherries

Flavor & Texture: ripe, sweet berries and subtle mineral liven the palate while the finish is clean and bright

Food Pairing: desserts such as cheesecake with wild berries and cream
