

# 2011 ROSSO TOSCANO

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'CAMPAPERI' – IL VALENTIANO  
TUSCANY, ITALY



## THE WINE:

65% Sangiovese Grosso (same clone as Brunello is made with), 30% Canaiolo, 5% Cabernet Sauvignon.

This “Super Tuscan” blend is mainly native Tuscan varieties with a splash of Cabernet.

## THE ESTATE:

Established in 1925 by Dino Ciacci this small, family run farm produces Olive Oil, fresh Brunello jam and Sangiovese-based wines. Dino’s grandson Fabiano Ciacci is now the winemaker. His wife Valentina manages the cellar. The grapes are all hand-picked and grown without the use of pesticides in the traditional Tuscan method.

## TASTING NOTES:

**COLOR:** Garnet with a brick red hue.

**AROMAS:** Cherry cordial with hints of marzipan and iron ore.

**FLAVORS:** Woodsy, cedar spice and cherry.

**FOOD PAIRING:** Fresh homemade pizza with spicy Italian pepperoni.
