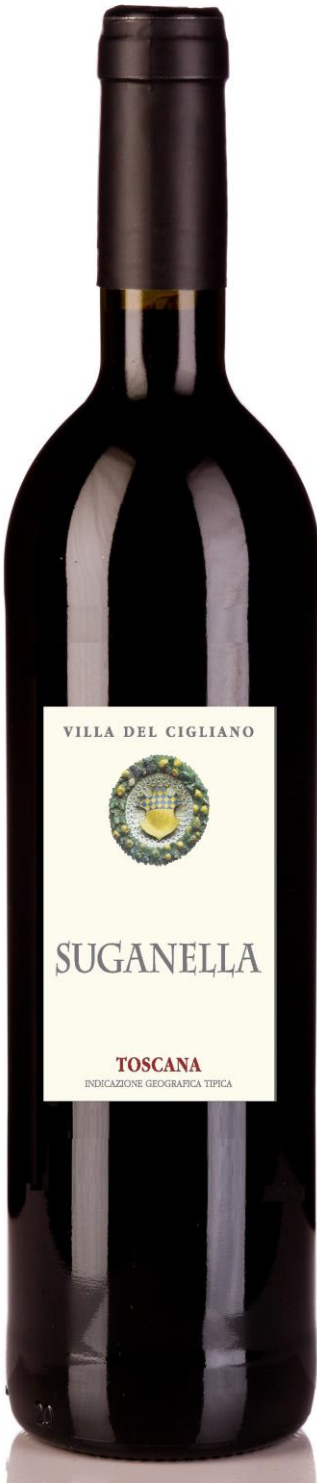


2011 SUGANELLA – SUPER TUSCAN

VILLA DEL CIGLIANO
TUSCANY, ITALY



THE WINE:

50% Cabernet Sauvignon/50% Sangiovese Super Tuscan. Very small production of only 600 cases. Vines are 45 years old. Barrel aged for 18 months in French oak 225 liters.

THE ESTATE:

Villa del Cigliano has been in the Antinori family since 1500. Located in the Chianti Classico area near the village of San Cassiano, about 15 miles outside of Florence. Vineyards are approximately 250–350 meters above sea level with Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, and Merlot, along with Colorino, Trebbiano, and Malvasia.

Winemaker: Niccolo Montecchi

TASTING NOTES:

COLOR: Deep crimson with ruby tones.

AROMAS: Sweet, dark cherry and spicy red currants. Undertones of vanilla oak with traces of sweet tobacco and red licorice.

FLAVORS AND TEXTURE: Intense fruits with notes of subtle spice. Mouth filling but with silky soft tannins and elegant structure.

FOOD PAIRING: Great with grilled meats and mature, hard cheeses.
