

2013 SUGANELLA SUPER TUSCAN

VILLA DEL CIGLIANO, CHIANTI CLASSICO REGION, TUSCANY, ITALY



THE WINE:

50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Merlot, 25% Sangiovese. Vines average age is 45 years old. All estate grown on Villa Del Cigliano. Barrel aged for 18 months in 225 liter French oak. Less than 450 cases made in 2013.

THE ESTATE:

Villa del Cigliano has been in the Antinori family since 1500. Located in the Chianti Classico area near the village of San Cassiano, about 15 miles outside of Florence. Vineyards are approximately 250-350 meters above sea level with Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, and Merlot, along with Colorino, Trebbiano, and Malvasia.

Winemaker: Niccolo Montecchi

TASTING NOTES:

Color: deep crimson red

Aromas: red cherry and cedar spices along with dried herbs and hints of roasted coffee beans

Flavor & Texture: bright red fruit and Tuscan earth tones lead to a silky palate with dry, but elegantly framed tannins

Food Pairing: fresh pasta with a classic bolognese sauce
