

# 2014 ANTIGVA CRIANZA, RIBERA DEL DUERO

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## ANTIGVA WINES, ALT PENEDES, SPAIN



### THE WINE:

This 100% Tempranillo is sourced from a single vineyard of 50 year old vines on the high plateau of the Ribera Del Duero region of Spain. The vines are low yielding and are hand pruned and hand picked, insuring only beautifully ripe berries reach the press. After gentle pressing and fermentation at controlled temperatures the wine is aged for 12 months in a combination of new French and American oak barrels.

### THE ESTATE:

Antigma Wines is a family run business going back five generations owned by the Figuerola family. They have been growing grapes in the Alt Penedés region of Catalonia near the town of Torrelles de Foix and only recently decided to start producing their own wines. The family also owns five acres of old vine tempranillo vines near the town of Roa in the Ribera del Duero D.O. The wines they make are all from estate grown fruit and grown without pesticides. They are truly a garage wine-maker with production levels under 3000 cases on any wine they produce.

### TASTING NOTES:

**Color:** violet-red hues with a purple core

**Aromas:** deep red and black cherry mingle with unique, clove like spices along with vanilla oak

**Flavor & Texture:** ripe fruits and hints of balsamic lead into vanilla and tobacco notes; the body is rich and round with a soft, voluptuous mouthfeel

**Food Pairing:** moroccan lamb kabobs with a mint and hazelnut pesto
