

2013 GODELLO CEPAS UNICAS

SEÑORÍO DEL BIERZO, BIERZO, SPAIN



THE WINE:

100% Godello from the Bierzo region of Northwest Spain. Made from a single vineyard with vines averaging 60 years old. Fermented 50% in French oak and 50% in concrete. Fruit is hand-picked and hand-sorted. Total production of fewer than 800 cases.

THE ESTATE:

Senorio del Bierzo is a cooperative of growers who sell their fruit to winemaker Pablo Franco. All single vineyard wines, typically from old vine plots. The wines are made from the typical grapes of the Bierzo D.O. in the Northwest corner of Spain – Mencía for reds and Godello for whites.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: straw golden

Aromas: white peach and jasmine flower showing chalky mineral and hints of nut oil

Flavor & Texture: subtle citrus and white fruits with jicama and mineral; rich and round on the palate with soft acids

Food Pairing: baked sea bass in parchment paper with garlic, lemon, fennel, fresh herbs, and this wine
