SEÑORIO DEL BIERZO, SPAIN



THE WINE:

100% Godello from the Bierzo region of Northwest Spain. Sourced from a single vineyard with 60 – 80 year old vines. Vinified and aged in a combination of steel and concrete – no oak. Godello vines are unusual in the world of white wines in their productivity even after many years - these vines being over 60 years old.

THE ESTATE:

Señorio del Bierzo is a cooperative of growers who sell their fruit to winemaker Pablo Franco. All single vineyard wines, typically from old vine plots. The wines are made from the typical grapes of the Bierzo D.O. in the Northwest corner of Spain – Mencia for reds and Godello for whites.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: light, straw hued gold

Aromas: fresh cut apples, hints of wild flowers and honey

Flavor & Texture: citrus, green apple and fresh picked herbs with a crisp and light body-style

Food Pairing: seafood paella
