THE WINE:

100% Albariño estate grown by Prado Alen winery. Cold soak fermentation in stainless steel. No oak aging.

THE ESTATE:

Vineyards are 35 miles from the Atlantic coast of Spain just north of the Portuguese border in the province of Pontevedra, Spain. The sandy, acidic soil in this region causes low yields with a very concentrated grape. The winery produces 140,000 bottles per year of Albariño-based wines. The Albariño grape has been grown in this area for over 800 years and reaches its highest quality in the Rias Baixas region.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Shimmering platinum-gold.

Aromas: Fresh and clean with stone fruit, bright citrus and minerals. Notes of anise.

Flavors & Texture: Refreshing, light and lively with citrusy tang, Meyer lemon and sea-spray. Crispy acidity on the finish creates an ultimate summer-style white.

Food Pairing: Shellfish salad such as grilled shrimp Caesar.
